Choice Board for Book Report

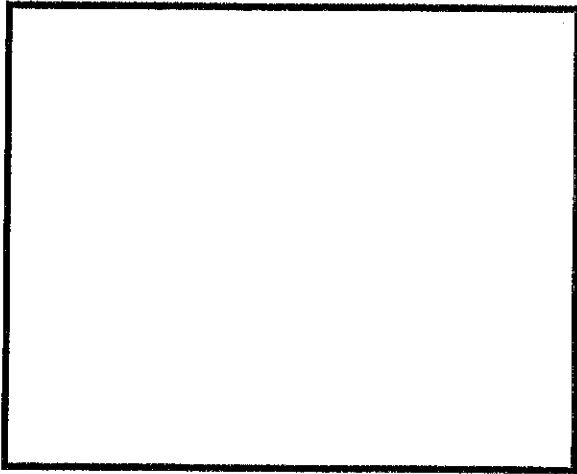
Choose 3 activities to complete for each book.

<p>Diorama Use a shoebox to create a scene from the book. Use art supplies to create the scene. Use an index card to write at least 2 sentences explaining the scene.</p>	<p>Father's Day Card Pretend you are one of the characters in the book. Create a Father's Day Card as the character writing to their father.</p>	<p>Poster Ad Use a piece of copy paper to make a catchy advertisement for your book using pictures and words.</p>
<p>Comic Strip Make a comic strip (6 pictures) of the main events in the story. This should be drawn and colored on a sheet of paper.</p>	<p>Next Chapter Pretend that the book is not over. Write the next chapter of the book (1-3 pages)</p>	<p>Biography Make a biography with pictures and facts about a character in the book. (I have attached a template. If you need more than one you can make a copy)</p>
<p>Quiz Game Write 5 true/false questions, 5 multiple choice questions, and 5 matching questions about the book.</p>	<p>Setting Draw and color a picture of your favorite part of the story. Write a paragraph explaining what is happening and why it is your favorite part. The paragraph should be at least 5 sentences.</p>	<p>Letter Pretend that you are a character from the book writing a letter to another character in the book (1 page). Include events in the book in the letter.</p>
