My dear parishioners, sisters and brothers,

Since my diagnosis of Tranverse Myelitis, I have received the best medical treatment and therapy. As a result, I am feeling so much better that I believe strongly with God's permission that I will make a full and fast recovery.

During these Easter days, I have been a patient in the Mayo Clinic in Phoenix, Arizona where some other tests are still being taken in order to get an updated evaluation after the treatment I received back in February while I was in Monterrey at the hospital. The medical attention and all other services here have been outstanding. I'm still waiting for the results of the most recent tests.

In addition to your fervent prayers, I'm also heartily thankful for your most generous contributions to pay off my debt with the Zambrano Hospital in Monterrey, the doctors' fees and other medical expenses. With the financial support I have received, I should be able to cover the costs of copayments, physical therapies and specialist doctors. I am astounded and deeply moved with your generous response dear sisters and brothers.

Meanwhile I pray, that after your devoted participation in the holy celebrations of Holy Week, this joyful Easter season will bring to each of you the true Peace that only our Risen Lord can offer to our sometimes restless hearts. We will listen at Mass this Divine Mercy Sunday when our Risen Lord told his disciples "peace be with you" and as He had told them before "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid".

But with all that being said and with such warm greetings, did Our Lord's disciples' trials, test, persecutions and all other kind of tribulations come to an end with his resurrection from the dead? By no means! Nonetheless, they had already received from Our Lord Jesus that peace in their hearts that the world nor any other human power could ever take away from them. The most incomparable gift and fruit from our Risen Lord granted to us in this Easter season is the Pax Christi, the Peace of Christ, la Paz de Cristo that no one could take away from us and that only Our Good Lord can grant to us.
